

# 2011-2012 Influenza Biological and Administration Coding Guide

CPT® - Biological/Agent	Description	Age
90654	<b>NEW for 2012!</b> influenza virus vaccine, split virus, preservative free, for <b>intra</b> dermal use	18 years to 64 years
90655	influenza virus vaccine, split virus, preservative free, for intramuscular use	6 months - 35 months
90656	influenza virus vaccine, split virus, preservative free, for intramuscular use	3 years and older
90657	influenza virus vaccine, split virus, for intramuscular use	6 months - 35 months
90658	influenza virus vaccine, split virus, for intramuscular use	3 years and older
90660	influenza virus vaccine, live, intranasal use	2 years to 49 years
90662	influenza virus vaccine, split virus, <i>enhanced immunogenicity via increased antigen content</i> preservative free, for intramuscular use	65 years and older

## BIOLOGICAL "Q" HCPCS FOR MEDICARE PATIENTS

*(The following "Q" HCPCS codes are to be used when billing for the biological portion of the influenza vaccine, split virus, intramuscular, age 3 years and older, given to Medicare recipients. **For Medicare billing purposes only**, the "Q" codes replace CPT® 90658.*

Q2039	not otherwise specified (NOS)	3 years and older

*CPT® 90662, influenza virus vaccine, split virus, enhanced immunogenicity is unchanged by the Q HCPCS codes.*

CPT®/HCPCS - Administration	Description
90471	immunization administration (includes percutaneous, intradermal, subcutaneous, or intramuscular injections), 1 vaccine
(add-on) 90472	immunization administration (includes percutaneous, intradermal, subcutaneous, or intramuscular injections), each additional vaccine
90473	immunization administration by intranasal or oral route, 1 vaccine
(add-on) 90474	immunization administration by intranasal or oral route, each additional vaccine
