**ISMS Board Action Taken on 10/22/2022**

**Adopted Resolution 09.2022-16 (A-23), as amended by the Council on Education & Health Workforce.**

Council on Education & Health Workforce Recommendation to ISMS Board on  
10/22/2022

This resolution calls for ISMS, in accordance with ACGME guidelines, support and protect residency training for women's reproductive health and all of its manifestations.

The author of the resolution, Dr. Nancy Church, was available for explanation and comment on the resolution and to address any questions. Dr. Church stated that the purpose of the resolution is to ensure residency training in regard to reproductive health at all medical facilities in the state.

The Council supported the goal of the resolution and focused particularly on the importance of adjusting the wording of the resolved statement to be consistent with ACGME language. The Council agreed to amended Resolution 09.2022-16 (A-23).

The Council on Education & Health Workforce recommends that the ISMS Board of Trustees adopt Resolution 09.2022-16 (A-23), as amended:

RESOLVED, that in accordance with ISMS support ACGME OB/GYN Program Requirements, which specify requirements for guidelines, ISMS support and protect residency training for in women's reproductive health and all of its manifestations.
