Council on Education & Health Workforce Recommendation to ISMS Board on  
10/22/2022

This resolution calls for the ISMS delegation to the AMA to submit a resolution to the AMA requesting that Policy H-275.970, Licensure Confidentiality, be amended.

The author of the resolution, Dr. Barbara Jericho, was available for explanation and comment on the resolution and to address any questions. Dr. Jericho stated that the purpose of the resolution is to protect physicians from any stigma or consequences related to disclosure of mental health issues, particularly in regard to sanctions in the areas of licensing or credentialing.

The Council supported adoption of this resolution, and concurred that amending the AMA policy on Licensure Confidentiality would address these issues of potential discrimination and confidentiality violations in the licensing, privileging and credentialing processes.

The Council on Education & Health Workforce recommends that the ISMS Board of Trustees adopt Resolution 09.2022-17 (A-23), as submitted.
