~~RESOLVED, that ISMS write a resolution asking that our AMA to advocate against the use of current students or graduates of AAMC LCME-accredited medical schools as a source of profit for medical licensure examinations; and be it further~~

RESOLVED, that the Illinois State Medical Society introduce a resolution to the American Medical Association House of Delegates asking the AMA to ISMS advocate for medical licensure examinations and related study, practice examinations, and examination preparatory materials released by the National Board of Medical Examiners and the National Board of Osteopathic Medical Examiners to be available at a cost to American medical students that does not exceed the reasonable cost of services to provide providing the examination and examination preparatory materials with no net profit from the medical student's examination fees.
