RESOLVED, that ISMS supports Illinois law which requires that any driver involved in a personal injury or fatal motor vehicle accident be given a breath test or chemical test of blood, breath, other bodily substance, or urine for the purpose of determining the content of alcohol, marijuana, other drugs, or intoxicating compounds when arrested ~~endorse the concept that Illinois drivers in fatal vehicle accidents be tested for drugs including marijuana; and be it further~~

~~RESOLVED, that ISMS recommend that the acceptable Illinois standards for marijuana be lowered to 2 mil THC ng.~~
