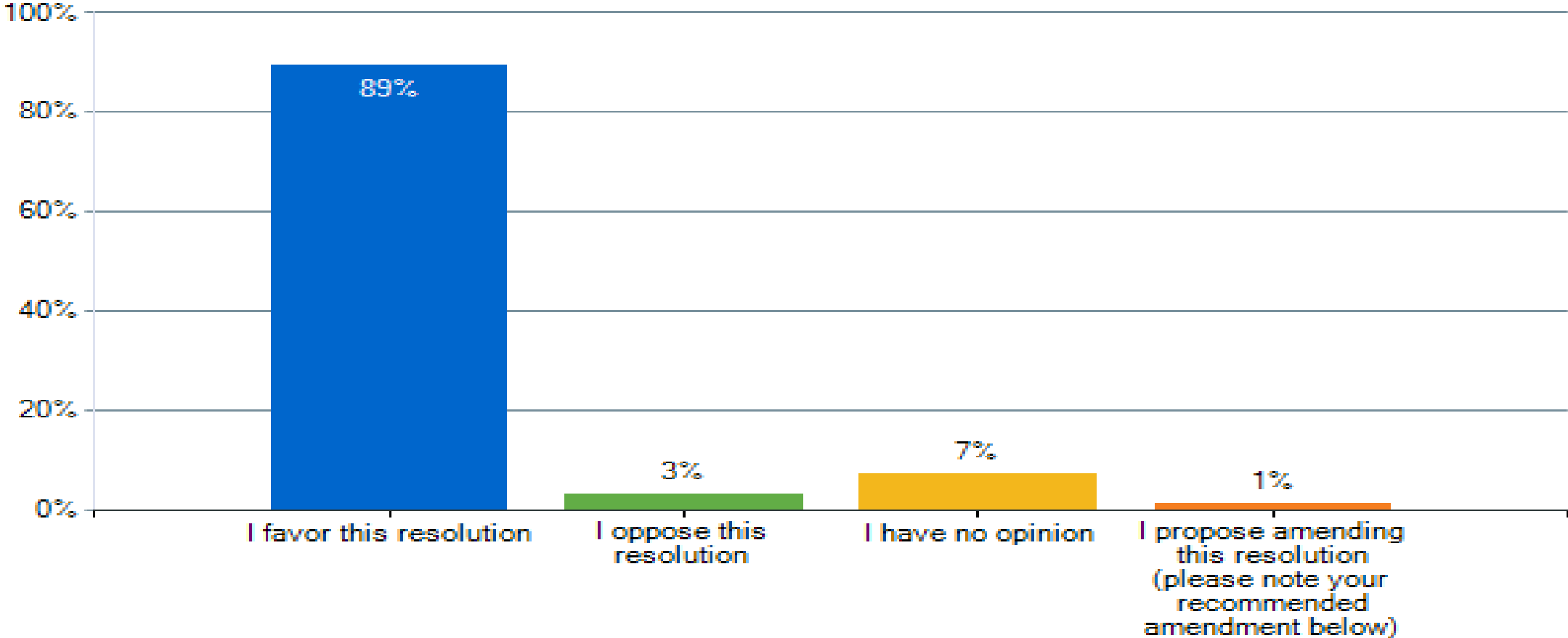
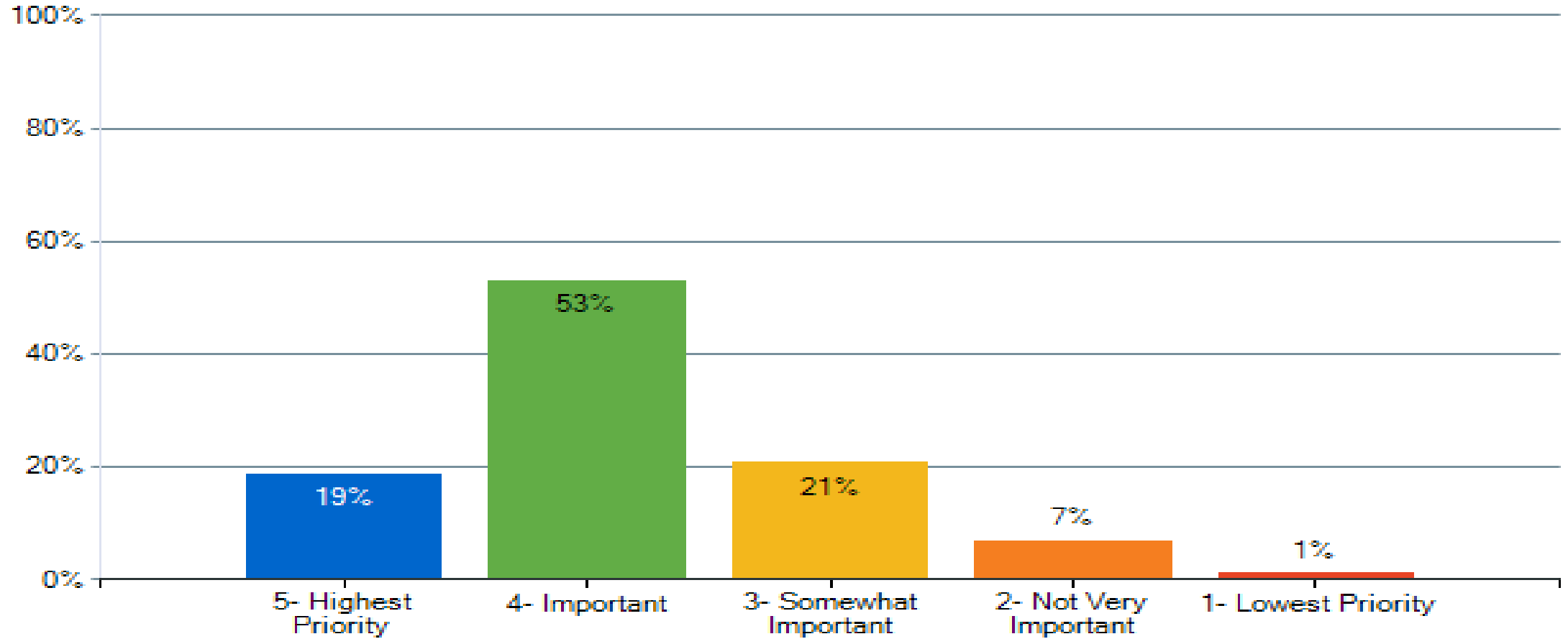


Cybersecurity as a Patient Safety Issue
