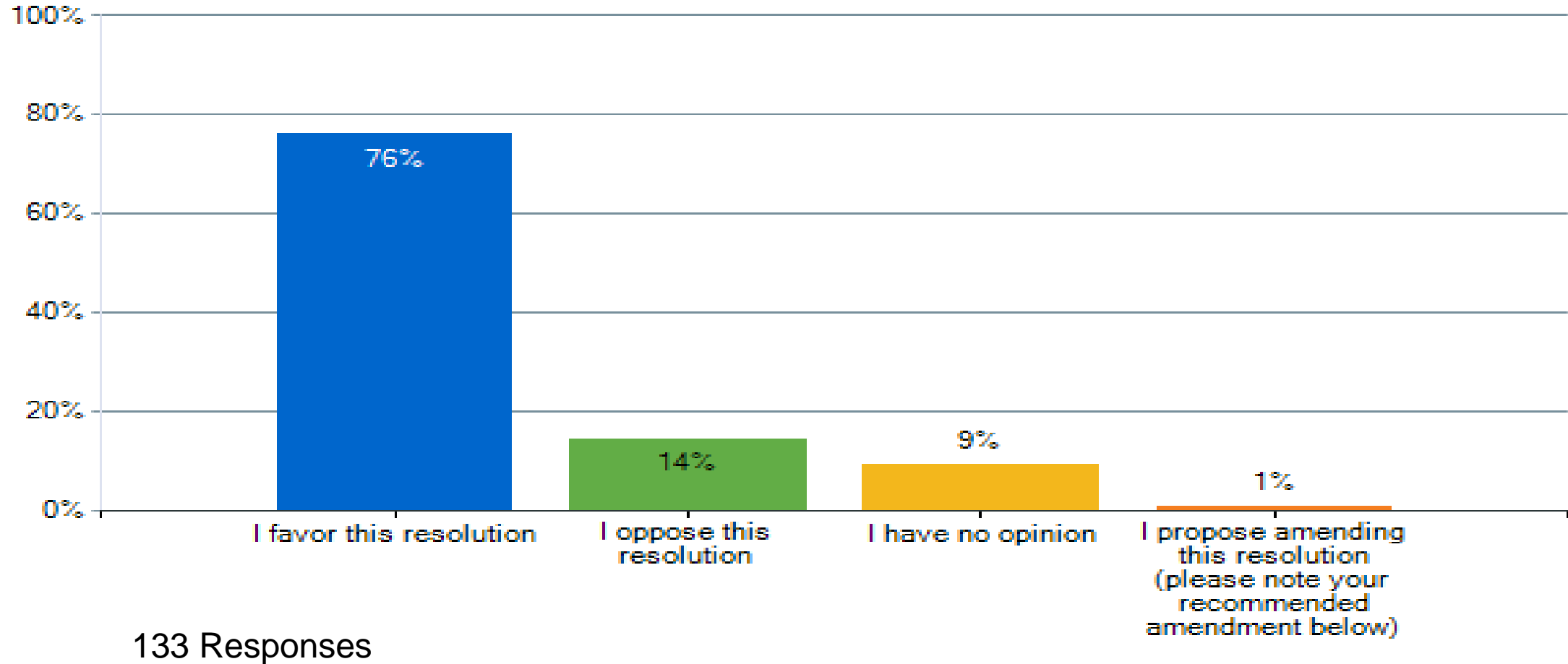
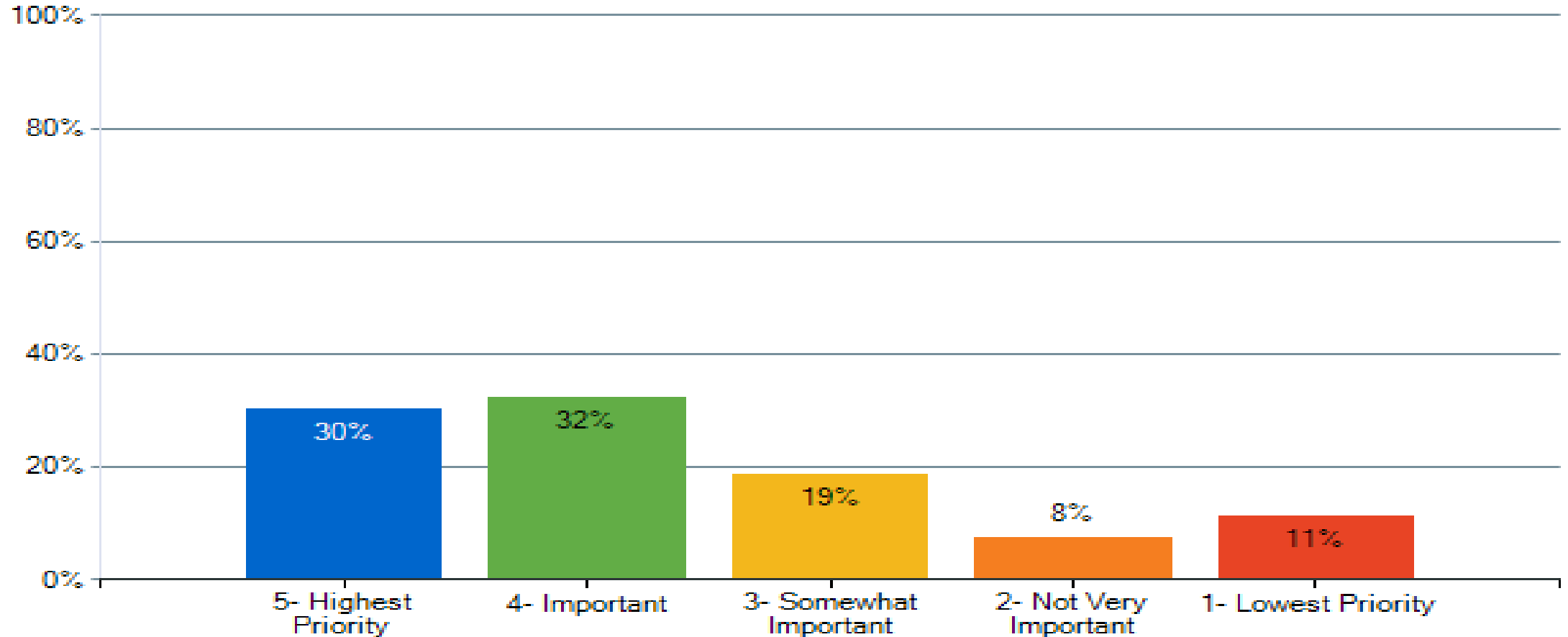


Ban Vaping in Cars with Passengers Below 18
