

FALSIFYING DISABILITY INFORMATION IS A CRIME

Fraud and abuse of the Parking Program for Persons with Disabilities is a serious problem. Medical professionals can be part of the solution. Falsifying information about the nature of a disability in order to qualify for disability license plates or parking placard is a crime—whether done by the applicant or the medical professional.

An applicant faces a 12-month suspension of driving privileges, a fine of up to \$2,500 and revocation of disabled parking privileges.

A medical professional also faces a suspension of driving privileges and a fine.
