**RESOLUTION 02.2019-28 (A-19), PROVISION OF HEALTH CARE IN ILLINOIS STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES**

**Adopted Substitute Resolution 02.2018-28 (A-19) in lieu of Resolution 02.2019-28 (A-19), as follows:**

1           RESOLVED, that ISMS encourage the Illinois Department of Corrections to  
2 pursue independent accreditation (such as by the National Commission on  
3 Correctional Health Care) of the health care services provided to inmates in order to  
4 help improve and maintain the standard of care consistent with community standards  
5 and evidence-based medicine; and be it further

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7           RESOLVED, that ISMS encourage the Illinois Department of Corrections to  
8 ensure that they have the necessary oversight and authority over medical care provided  
9 by contracted third-party vendors to ensure the appropriate level and quality of  
10 primary, secondary and tertiary care available to inmates; and be it further

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12           RESOLVED, that ISMS encourage the Illinois Department of Corrections to  
13 support involvement of medical and academic institutions that are interested in  
14 participating in the provision of correctional health services which are consistent in  
15 level and quality with the care provided to other segments of the population.
